

MAKE YOUR WAY TO acon


About 90 minutes south of Atlanta, straight down I-75, Macon boasts historic Southern charm and grace with plenty of culture to go around.

Off Balance

Having good balance means you are able to control and maintain your body's position, whether you are moving or still. An intact sense of balance helps you walk without staggering, get up from a chair without falling, and climb stairs without tripping.

Good balance is important to help you get around, stay independent, and carry out daily activities.

A balance disorder is a disturbance of the inner ear that can make people feel unsteady or as if they were moving, spinning or floating. Balance disorders are one cause of falls and fall-related injuries, such as hip fracture.


Balance disorders can have a serious impact on an older person's life. They are one reason older people fall. A fall or a life of limited physical activity due to balance disorders can lead to health problems, isolation, and loss of independence. Falls and fall-related injuries, such as hip fracture, are the leading cause of death and disability for older adults.

Some balance disorders are caused by problems in the inner ear. Others may involve another part of the body, such as the brain or the heart. Aging, infections, head injury, certain medicines or problems with blood circulation may result in a balance problem.


Your diet and lifestyle can help you manage certain balance-related problems. Ménière's disease is linked to a change in the volume of fluid in the inner ear. By eating low-salt or salt-free foods, and steering clear of caffeine and alcohol, you can make its symptoms, such as vertigo, less severe.

Eating less sodium, maintaining a healthy weight, and exercising can manage balance problems due to high blood pressure. Balance problems due to low blood pressure may be managed by drinking plenty of fluids, such as water, avoiding alcohol, and being cautious regarding your body's posture and movement, such as avoiding crossing your legs when sitting and standing up slowly. Scientists are working to understand the complex interactions between the brain and the part of the inner ear responsible for balance. They are also studying the effectiveness of certain exercises as a treatment option for balance disorders.

ROAD TRIP







l^{1/2} lbs ground beef
3 cans drained chili beans
salt and pepper
2 cans diced tomatoes
1 can of Rotelle diced tomatoes with chiles
chili powder to taste
1 or 2 cans tomato soup with l/2 can of water
2 stalks of celery
l green pepper
l medium onion

Brown ground beef and then saute the celery, green pepper and onion. Add the beans and tomatoes to meat mixture. Add soup with water and stir. Bring to boil and simmer on stove. Can be cooked in a slow cooker or crock pot, but is better on the stove.
